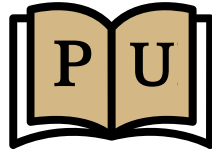





LIBRARIES MAP

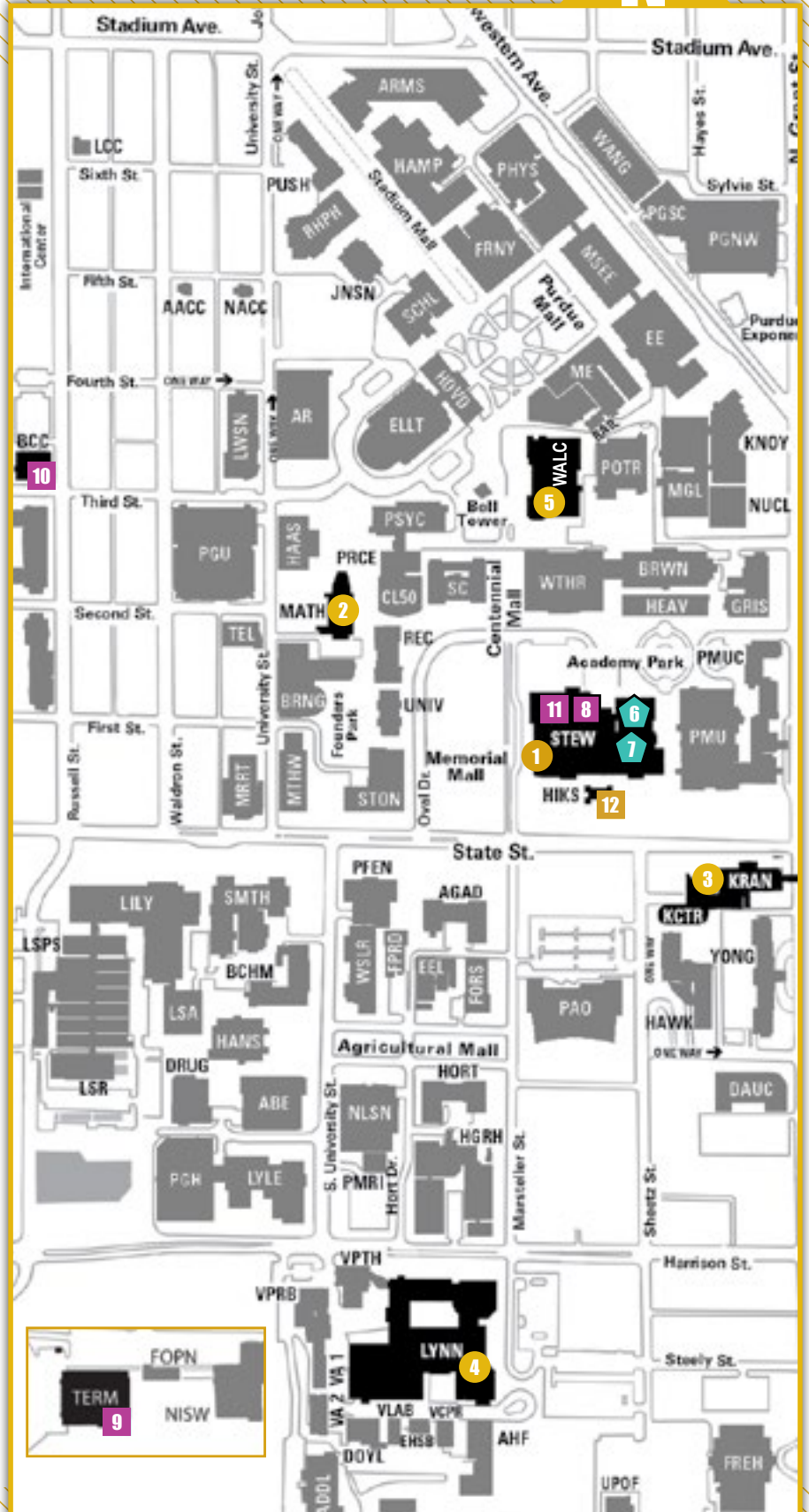

Collections — lib.purdue.edu

The Purdue University Library system includes more than 3.8 million printed volumes and electronic books, close to 165,000 electronic and print journals, more than 377,000 government document, and over 86,000 microforms.



Find Journals & full-text articles online

Use the FIND button in the Libraries toolbar to locate full-text journals in Purdue Libraries databases. Browse or search by title, and even get a link to the database.



Books

Newly acquired books are shelved using the Library of Congress (LC) call number system, which begins with a letter. Most other books use the Dewey Decimal System, which begin with a number. Please ask staff at the information desk in any library for help locating books. Starting Fall 2020, books and other physical materials will be quarantined for 72-hours before being re-shelved.

Printing - (Prints, Posters, and 3-D Prints)

Printing is available in all Libraries. Color printing is available in the Veterinary Medicine Library (LYNN 1133D), HSSE Library (STEW 153), Hicks Undergraduate Library (HIKS G950) and the WALC.

Poster Printers are available in the Undergraduate Library (HIKS) and in the Wilmeth Active Learning Center (WALC), second floor.

In the WALC, Purdue University Libraries offers free 3-D printing for items less than 50 grams, with a total limit of 100g per month.
